



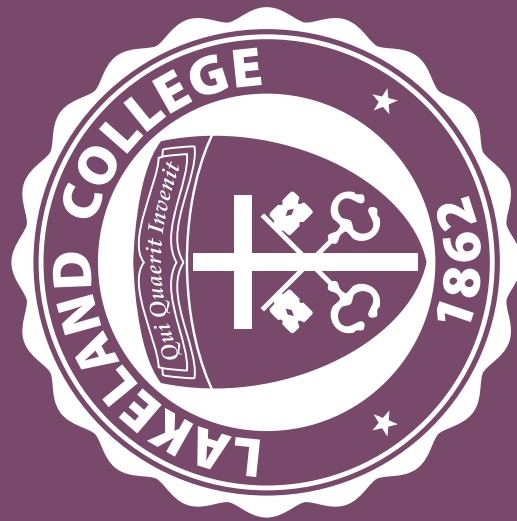

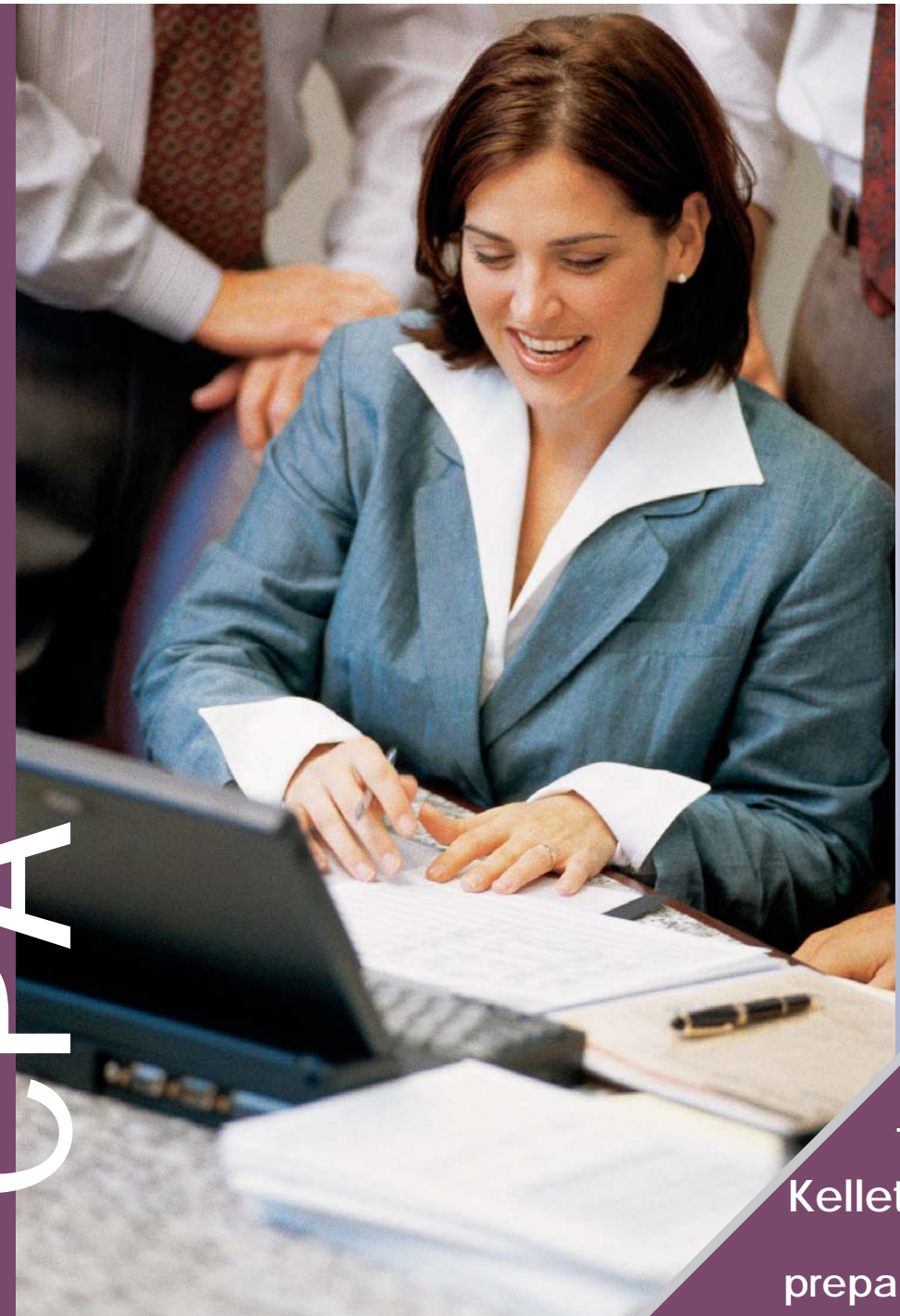

The Basics
