Fall term starts on Monday, August 25, 2014 Spring term starts on Wednesday, January 7, 2015



Figures are meant to serve as guidelines and are subject to change, in order to obtain a student visa, you must prove that you will be supported fully for your entire course of study.

**Tuition & Fees** \$24,090 per academic year (\$12,045 per academic term)

An undergraduate international student must take a minimum of 12 credits each term (fall and spring) to maintain his/her visa status. Summer term is optional; however, additional expenses for tuition and books will result if you take summer classes. Most of our courses are 3-credit courses; therefore, 12 credits are 4 courses.

You may take up to 18 credits each term without additional tuition cost.

**Commitment Deposit** \$100 (one time fee for new international students only)

Housing Deposit \$200

**Room and Meals (on campus)** \$8090 per academic year (double occupancy room in halls with 150 meals per term)

You may select 100, 150 or 200 meals per term. Plans with more meals cost more.

**Books** \$950 (estimated)

**Health Insurance** \$1,500 (estimated for 12 months)

**Miscellaneous Personal Expenses** \$2,000 (based on 9 month academic term)\*

**Total for a SEVIS I-20** \$36,930 (estimated for 12 months)

\*Please note if you choose to study in the summer and live on-campus, you will have additional tuition, fees, and room and board costs. You could anticipate an additional \$1700-\$3000 in expenses.

**Grants** Lakeland College provides financial assistance based upon a review of academic success and financial need. Only students whose Lakeland College applications are completed will be considered for these awards.

**Employment** On and off campus employment opportunities, such as internships, and Optional Practical Training under the BCIS and/or Lakeland College rules and regulations are available. Please be aware that there are many restrictions on international student employment in the U.S.

**Deadlines** All international applications are processed on a rolling basis and there is no deadline. Your application for admission and supporting credentials should be submitted as early as possible to allow sufficient time to process your application, obtain your visa and arrange for transportation.
