## Important Camp Policies

- Resident campers must remain at camp for the entire week.
- Resident campers may not check out and then return.
- Commuter campers must be at camp from 8:00 AM until the end of the day's activities (approximately 9:30 PM).

## Cancellation/Refund Schedule

ON OR BEFORE JULY 13	Refund less \$50 administrative fee
JULY 14 - FIRST DAY OF CAMP	Refund less \$100 administrative fee
AFTER FIRST DAY OF CAMP	With written physician's note, pro-rated refund less \$100 administrative fee. <i>No refunds without physician's note.</i>

Refund issued only to original payer of fees. Refunds may take up to 3 weeks to complete.
