MBA PROGRAM ONLY Tuition & Fees

\$10,890 for 6 courses [18 credits] per year [\$1,815 per course or \$605 per credit]

A graduate F-1 visa international student must take a minimum of 9 credits each required term [fall and spring] to maintain his/her visa status. Summer term is optional; however additional expenses for tuition and books will result if you take summer classes. All MBA courses are 3 credit courses; therefore 9 credits are 3 courses. Most non-business graduate courses are 3 credit courses.

All international applications are processed on a rolling basis. Your application for admission and supporting credentials must be submitted at least 14 days prior to the start of the semester, but it is recommended that you apply earlier. This will allow sufficient time to process your application, obtain your visa and arrange for transportation. Only completed applications will be reviewed for acceptance consideration.
