



Tuition & Fees *Estimate*

UNDERGRADUATE DAY PROGRAMS TUITION RATES BATTEN AND BLACK SCHOLARS 2024-2025 Academic Year (September 2024 – May 2025)

Fall term dates: Wednesday, August 28, 2024 - Friday, December 13, 2024
Spring term dates: Tuesday, January 21, 2025 - Friday, May 9, 2025

To obtain a student visa, you must prove that you will be supported fully for your entire course of study. The cost estimates below are meant to serve as guidelines and are **subject to change**.

Tuition	\$31,900 per academic year (\$15,950 per term) *
Fees	\$1,496 per academic year (\$748 per term). There may be additional course fees for specific courses. These can be viewed on the lab fee schedule online. Professional certification course fees are an additional cost and not included in this estimate.
Commitment Deposit	\$100 (one-time fee for new international students only)
Housing Deposit	\$200 (one-time fee to reserve housing space)
Room and Meals (on campus)	\$12,140 (fall and spring only) **
Books	\$1,100
Health Insurance	\$2,538 (12 months)
Miscellaneous Personal Expenses	\$5,502 (fall and spring terms only, does not include travel which could cost an additional \$1,500 to \$3,000)
Total <u>without</u> Scholarship	\$54,976
Batten and Black Scholarship	-\$18,000 per academic year (-\$9,000 per academic term)
Total Estimate for SEVIS I-20 (<u>with</u> scholarship)	\$36,976 (8 months) ***

*\$31,900 is the net annual tuition. Students taking 12-18 credit hours will be billed the full-time day tuition rate initially and then financial aid will apply the Batten & Black Scholarship.

**Room costs are based on a double occupancy dorm room in a freshman hall. Meal costs are based on the All-Access Meal plan. If you select a different meal plan, your cost will be adjusted.

***If you choose to study in the summer and live on-campus, you will have additional tuition, fees, and room and board costs. The per credit rate is \$550. You could anticipate an additional \$3,000 to \$4,000 in expenses.

Batten and Black Scholarship - \$18,000 per academic year: \$9,000 for Fall (Aug-Dec) and \$9,000 for Spring (Jan-May). Awarded to students from Lakeland University Japan studying at Lakeland University Wisconsin.

Employment: On-campus employment opportunities are available. Off-campus opportunities may be available after the completion of two full-time semesters of attendance at Lakeland if the major selected requires completion of an internship. Any employment requires strict adherence to the DHS and Lakeland University rules and regulations. Please be aware that there are many restrictions on international student employment in the U.S.

Deadlines: All international applications are processed on a rolling basis and there is no deadline. Your application for admission and supporting credentials should be submitted as early as possible to allow sufficient time to process your application, obtain your visa and arrange for transportation. **Tuition, fees, room and board, and insurance charges for the semester are due in full prior to the first day of each semester.**
