



Tuition & Fees *Estimate*

UNDERGRADUATE DAY PROGRAMS TUITION RATES BATTEN AND BLACK SCHOLARS 2025-2026 Academic Year (August 2025 – May 2026)

Fall term dates: Wednesday, August 27, 2025 - Friday, December 12, 2025
Spring term dates: Tuesday, January 20, 2026 - Friday, May 8, 2026

To obtain a student visa, you must prove that you will be supported fully for your entire course of study.
The cost estimates below are meant to serve as guidelines and are **subject to change**.

Tuition	\$32,900 per academic year (\$16,450 per term) *
Fees	\$1,616 per academic year (\$808 per term). <i>There may be additional course fees for specific courses. These can be viewed on the lab fee schedule online. Professional certification course fees are an additional cost and not included in this estimate.</i>
Commitment Deposit	\$100 (one-time fee for new international students only)
Housing Deposit	\$200 (one-time fee to reserve housing space)
Room and Meals (on campus)	\$14,322 (fall and spring only) **
Books	\$1,100
Health Insurance	\$2,792 (12 months)
Miscellaneous Personal Expenses	\$5,658 (fall and spring terms only, does not include travel which could cost an additional \$1,500 to \$3,000)
Total <u>without</u> Scholarship	\$57,072
Batten and Black Scholarship	-\$18,000 per academic year (-\$9,000 per academic term)
Total Estimate for SEVIS I-20 (<u>with</u> scholarship)	\$39,072 (8 months) ***

*\$32,900 is the net annual tuition. Students taking 12-18 credit hours will be billed the full-time day tuition rate initially and then financial aid will apply the Batten & Black Scholarship.

**Room costs are based on a double occupancy dorm room in a freshman hall. Meal costs are based on the All-Access Meal plan. If you select a different meal plan, your cost will be adjusted.

***Studying for the summer and living on-campus would have additional tuition, fees, and room and board costs. The per credit rate for courses is \$550. You should expect an additional \$3,000 to \$4,000 in summer expenses.

Batten and Black Scholarship - \$18,000 per academic year: \$9,000 for Fall (Aug-Dec) and \$9,000 for Spring (Jan-May).
Awarded to students from Lakeland University Japan studying at Lakeland University Wisconsin.

Employment: On-campus job opportunities are available. Off-campus employment may be possible after completing two full-time semesters at Lakeland, but only if your major requires an internship. All employment must strictly follow DHS and Lakeland University regulations. Be aware that international student employment in the U.S. comes with many restrictions.

Deadlines: International applications are processed on a rolling basis with no set deadline. However, you should submit your application and supporting documents as early as possible to allow time for processing, obtaining a visa, and arranging transportation. **Tuition, fees, room and board, and insurance costs must be paid in full by the first day of each semester.**
