Off-Campus Login Information

To access the library databases:

- Check your course syllabus or Blackboard for the username and password.
- Go to the [library web page](http://www.lakeland.edu/academics/library). (www.lakeland.edu/academics/library)
- Click **Databases Find Articles**.
- Select the database you wish to search.
- Enter the library username and password.

Finding Journal/Magazine Articles

Access complete articles at no cost! Magazine articles, scholarly journals, company profiles, analyst reports and news articles are a click away. The library provides numerous databases to help you find articles on business-related topics.

Need a scholarly article? Look for a limiter within the database to restrict your results to scholarly journals.

Can't get to the library for a copy of the article? Limit your search results to those including a complete copy of the article by using the full-text limiter.

Academic Search Premier

- Covers a variety of topics including business.
- Popular, trade and scholarly articles

Business Source Complete

- Covers business only
- Popular, trade and scholarly articles
- Full-text from many journals including *Harvard Business Review*
- Datamonitor/MarketLine Company Profiles
- SWOT analysis
- Market research reports
- Industry reports
- Articles from business newspapers

MasterFILE Premier

- Popular magazines
- Trends

Newspaper Source Plus

- Newspaper articles
- Regional business publications.

Regional Business News

- Newspaper articles
- Regional business publications

Finding Journal/Magazine Articles con't

JSTOR

- Scholarly articles only; most prior to 2011.

LexisNexis Academic

- Court cases and state and federal laws
- Company profiles
- Brands/competitors
- SEC filings
- Current newspaper and industry trade press articles
- *Accountant's Handbook & Accountant's Liabilities*

ProQuest

Includes the following databases with business content:

ProQuest Research Library

- Newspaper, trade, popular & scholarly articles

ProQuest Psychology Journals

- Articles on psychological aspects of business such as marketing, human resources & teams.

Sage: scholarly articles only.

Finding Company Information

Publicly-traded companies are easier to research. The amount of information available for private companies is more limited.

Business Source Complete, available in EBSCOhost databases, includes a *Company Information* tab on the initial search screen. Click on the tab. Enter a company name in the search box. When your results appear, use the options on the left side of the screen to limit your results to SWOT analysis, industry profiles, market research reports and more.

EDGAR, available at <http://www.sec.gov/edgar.shtml> consists of documents filed with the U.S. Securities and Exchange commission. For help in searching and using the documents, go to <http://www.sec.gov/investor/pubs/edgarguide.htm>. These documents are also available in LexisNexis Academic.

LexisNexis Academic provides a *Get Company Info* search box that allows searching by company name or ticker symbol. Use the multitude of links that are included in each company record and along the left side of the screen to quickly move to the information you need. Includes competitor information, SEC filings, business descriptions, merger news and more.

Morningstar Investment Research (limited to 2 simultaneous users)

- Analyst reports
- Bond Ratings
- Publicly-traded company profiles
- Financial ratios
- Fund reports
- Stock quotes including historical quotes

Have you found a citation for an interesting article on the reference page of another article or in your textbook that you would like to locate? Give our **E Journal List A-Z** a try. Enter the name of the journal in which the cited article appeared and our **E Journal List** will tell you if that article can be found in one of Lakeland's databases.

Inter-library Loan

Found the perfect article, but it is not available online? Don't despair! Give the library's interlibrary loan services a try. Fill out the [interlibrary loan request form](#). We will request the article from another library and email it to you.

Let EBSCOhost create the citation for you. Retrieve the articles and click on



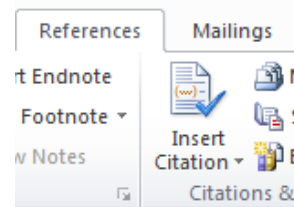
Citing an article from ProQuest?
