## IMPORTANT CAMP POLICIES

- Resident campers must remain at camp for the entire week.
- Resident campers may not check out and then return.

## CANCELLATION/REFUND SCHEDULE

<b>On or before July 15</b>	Refund less \$100 administrative fee
<b>July 16 – first day of camp</b>	Refund less \$200 administrative fee
<b>After first day of camp</b>	With written physician's note, pro-rated refund less \$100 administrative fee.
