

WELCOME TO MUSIC CAMP AT LAKELAND UNIVERSITY!

We're excited to welcome you aboard for our 66th Annual Music Camp from July 23rd to July 29th, 2023!

On the camp page are a few documents you should find helpful in the coming weeks and months to prepare for Music Camp. Please read all documents carefully. The camp website is: <u>www.lakeland.edu/MusicCamp</u> The forms needed for camp participation are as follows:

- 1) **Camp Application Form** The registration form is found on the main camp page listed above. After filling out the necessary information, submit the application and you will receive an email with further instructions. If you select the "Pay Now" option, you can pay online with credit/debit card immediately. If you are waiting on some information such as a school scholarship amount, you may select the "Pay Later" option and either mail in a check or pay via credit/debit card by phone by calling Lakeland University Business Office, 920-565-1027. School or organization scholarship checks may be mailed to the camp address below.
- 2) **Health Information** This information will be completed online at the time you register instead of as a separate form. Please contact camp staff with any updates should information change between registration and camp check-in.
- 3) **(optional) Honors Recital Application You can indicate interest in the Honors Recital when you register. If you select "Honors Recital," you will receive an email with further instructions. When filling out the Honors Recital application, you will be asked to enter information on your voice/instrument, the piece to be performed, and upload a copy of the piano accompaniment.
- 4) **Private Lessons** Individual lessons may be selected on the application. Private lessons cost \$25 in addition to normal camp tuition. Students will be paired with the appropriate teacher for their voice or instrument and the teacher will arrange a time to meet with them during the week of camp.
