

TO APPLY

1. Go to: Lakeland.edu/MusicCamp
2. Fill out the application form. This is where you will enter student and parent info as well as selecting ensemble and class preferences
3. select the Pay Now or Pay Later option and click "Submit"
4. You will receive a follow-up email. Follow the instructions to login and pay tuition as well as recital, lessons, or other fees. Reminders will be sent out periodically about payments and any additional information required.

IMPORTANT CAMP POLICIES

- Resident campers must remain at camp for the entire week.
- Resident campers may not check out and then return.

July 13 – first day of camp	Refund less \$200 administrative fee
After first day of camp	With written physician's note, pro-rated refund less \$100 administrative fee.

No refunds without physician's note.

Refund issued only to original payer of fees. Refunds may take up to 3 weeks to complete.
