AUDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY

IMPORTANT CAMP POLICIES

- Resident campers must remain at camp for the entire week.
- Resident campers may not check out and then return.
- Commuter campers must be at camp from 8:00 AM until the end of the day's activities (approximately 9:00 PM).

CANCELLATION/REFUND SCHEDULE

On or before July 14 Refund less \$100 administrative fee

July 15 – first day of camp Refund less \$200 administrative fee

After first day of camp With written physician's note,

pro-rated refund less \$100

administrative fee.

No refunds without physician's note.

Refund issued only to original payer of fees. Refunds may take up to 3 weeks to complete.
