BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA)

Objectives include an understanding of business and economic problems, and the development of managerial skills to address these problems in the context of an ethical and global workplace.

LEADERSHIP AND ORGANIZATIONAL DEVELOPMENT (MS-LOD)

The Master of Science in Leadership and Organizational Development (LOD) graduate program focuses on leadership skills and organizational development practices in the workplace; whereas the more traditional MBA focuses on accounting, finance, statistics and economics.

EDUCATION (M.Ed.)

Lakeland's M.Ed. faculty is a mix of our own talented education professors and respected educators and administrators from surrounding school districts.

COUNSELING (MAC)

This program complements the busy schedules of working music educators, allowing them to earn their Master of Music in Music Education – Kodály Emphasis degree in four summers, including an intensive two-week summer residency each summer, with limited online coursework throughout the academic year.
