

## Lakeland University Response Plan to COVID-19 in Residence Halls

When Lakeland University is notified of a residential student testing positive for the COVID-19 virus the following steps will be implemented:

- Identified student(s) will be rehoused in the Suites.
  - Suite 10 & 11 have been identified as self-isolation units.
    - There are 4 self-isolation units in each suite. All units are prepared and pre-stocked with essentials.
    - Identified essentials are:
      - Tissue & Soap,
      - ✓ Linens (Blankets, Pillows, Sheets, Sheet spread, body & face towels) Two sets per room
      - ✓ Garbage bags
      - ✓ Refrigerator(s) One per suite
      - ✓ Microwave(s) One per suite
    - Desk phones (Will be installed in each room)
    - Desk top Computers (Will be installed in common area for continued course work)
  - Students will only be able to bring the following necessities into isolated units:
    - TV/gaming units
    - Personal computers
    - Toiletries
    - Clothes (for two weeks)
- To protect residential students in self-isolation units, campus safety will deliver meals in the following:
  - o Students will contact campus safety via the following:
    - Personal cell
    - In room phone
  - Campus Safety officers will pick up meals from dining services and drop off at a designated area. (All
    officers will take the necessary precautions)
    - Students will also have the ability to pre-order food and have meals in three day increments.
- Students would be monitored by way of a medical professionals via the following:
  - Email,
  - o Phone call
  - Text/survey app
  - Web base meetings/screenings
- If conditions worsen residents will be instructed to contact the following:
  - o **911**
- Any students housed in the designated isolation units cannot have guest. Exceptions to this will be the following:
  - o Campus Safety
  - Emergency medical personnel/Responders
  - Parents (notification given before arrival)
- Once a student(s) have been cleared per medical professionals and free of any symptoms for 72 hours w/o
  medication. Students will only be able to return to general population residential halls after they complete the
  following:
  - Wash all clothes
  - Disinfect and wipe down all personal belongings
- Once isolation unit is no longer occupied is will undergo a disinfectant treatment process;
- Communication to the Lakeland community:
  - Communications will be prepared by the director of external relations for the following groups:
    - All students
    - Employees and trustees
    - Parents of current students
    - Possible communication for broader community per needs of public health
    - Add info to Lakeland.edu/coronavirus page
  - Director of external relations will serve as the contact for all media.
    - Evaluation of the need for press conference working with public health officials.
